When traveling, remember that you should leave as few traces of human presence as possible.

THEREFORE,
PLEASE FOLLOW THESE
SIMPLE, BUT IMPORTANT
RULES:



Do not damage, cut, dig out, or pull our plants



Do not collect deadwood, pine and spruce twigs, break brunches



Do not disturb wild animals and their habitats. Watch them from a distance



Do not pick chicks with your hands and carry them away



Do not damage the soil cover and dig pits



If you travel by car, do not drive outside existing roads



Do not camp and make fire on sites not previously used by humans. Try to use available camping sites



If possible, use gas burners and take waste with you



Listen to the sounds of nature without loudspeaking devices
